American Electric Power Service Corporation, on behalf of its affiliates, AEP Appalachian Power Company, Indiana Michigan Power Company, Kentucky Power Company, Kingsport Power Company, Ohio Power Company, and Wheeling Power Company (collectively “AEP” or “the AEP East Companies”), hereby submits for filing for informational purposes a revision to correct an administrative oversight to the 2023 projected annual transmission revenue requirement (“PTRR”) submitted in this docket on November 1, 2022. This revision updates the 2023 Network Service Peak Loads (NSPL) from the preliminary NSPL of 21,741.0 MWs to the final 21,717.1 MWs pursuant to the Network Integration Transmission Service Agreement between PJM and AEP, which was finalized by PJM on November 18, 2022. This revision impacts the PTRR FR Summary 2023.xlsx and the 2023 Projected RTEP AEP Summary.doc files included in the November 1, 2022, filing.
