Subject Belmont-Kammer 765 Outage on 10/1

Gentlemen:

We have a general concern about congestion in the Belmont area of APS starting Monday, 10/1, which could hamper Moutnaineer and other 765kV unit generation:

The Kammer 765/500kV transformer - Harrison tap line, the Belmont-Kammer 765kV line, and possibly an APS unit at Pleasants are all scheduled out starting Monday.

The Kammer transformer outage is scheduled thru Wednesday 10/3, and the Belmont-Kammer outage is scheduled thru 11/2.

Both have been approved by PJM.

Do we have any say in the scheduling of these transmission outages?

Would it be feasible to postpone the start of the Belmont-Kammer outage until the Kammer transformer is back in service to eliminate the possibility of congestion?
