- As of 2022 the region's population **declined by 0.3%** since 2017, falling by 1,244. Population is expected to **increase by 4.4%** between 2022 and 2027, adding 19,351.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 2.5% in Kentucky Power-Served Counties from 135,343 to 131,910. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 2.4% by 4.9%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 41.7% to 40.2% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **7.6% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (13.1% below the national average), and **8.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (the same as the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), General Medical and Surgical Hospitals, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.







Unemployment by Gender










Unemployment Rate Trends








Top Industry Location Quotient






Largest Occupations




Top Growing Occupations




Top Occupation Location Quotient



Top Occupation Earnings




